NOTIFICATION

As part of the accommodation review process, the final report for Sir James Dunn Public School has been posted and includes the following recommendation:

Consistent with the Initial Staff Report and based on the School Information Profile feedback and public input, it is Senior Administration's recommendation that the JK-8 school population, staff and program currently housed at Sir James Dunn Public School be relocated to a JK-12 facility on the Michipicoten High School site. It is also recommended that the Algoma District School Board investigate potential community partnerships with whom space can be shared at the JK-12 site, thereby making it a desirable community hub. It is acknowledged that these recommendations are contingent upon the Algoma District School Board applying for and receiving Ministry of Education Capital Funding for renovations to Michipicoten High School. If funding is not available, the elementary program would remain at the Sir James Dunn site subject to future considerations.

As outlined in Algoma District School Board Policy 5.01: Pupil and Accommodation Review Policy, the Board must allow an opportunity for members of the public to provide feedback through a public delegation to the Board of Trustees no fewer than 10 business days after the final staff report is posted.

The Board has set aside Tuesday, May 30, at 6:00 pm as a special Board meeting to provide such opportunity. The meeting will be held at the Education Centre which is located at 644 Albert Street East, Sault Ste. Marie. Presentations may be made in person at the Education Centre, or by videoconference in Wawa.
