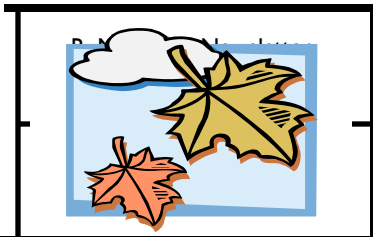

Character Education

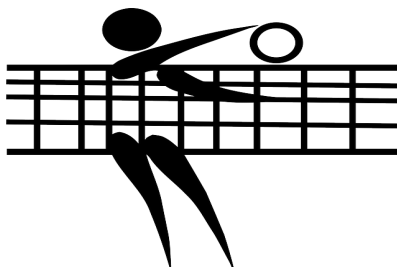
November's attribute will be "Loyal and Respect".
