Fundraising

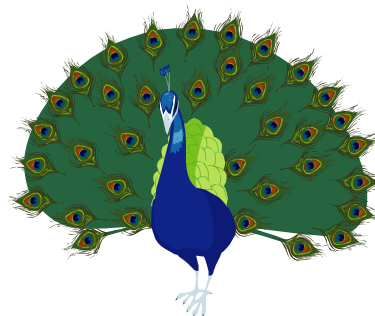
