









# Algoma District School Board Alliance Academy Minds in Motion Academic Program Information Package 2025-2026

#### Vision

The Vision of the Algoma District School Board Alliance Academy is that learners in ADSB engage in innovative experiences that maximize achievement, build confidence, and develop responsible citizens.

The Alliance Minds In Motion Academy is open to male and female students in grades 9 and 10 who meet the criteria for enrolment at each Sault Ste. Marie secondary school.

The ADSB Alliance Minds In Motion Academy will help student athletes learn and improve advanced individual skills and tactics, while developing a lifestyle in and away from their sport that emphasizes building character through achieving both athletic and educational success.

Purposeful training sessions led by highly trained staff, strength and conditioning designed to maximize physical attributes, and a focus on leadership, character and confidence will all position the student to achieve their individual goals in an engaging environment.

# High School Program (grades 9 and 10) – Second semester only

- ➤ Paired programming for success: PAL 10/20, (Physical Education large group activities) and English (Grade 9 or 10 English)
- 110 hours of training in Kick boxing, jiu Jitsu, boxing, and wrestling development
- 110 hours of grade 9 or 10 English
- Instruction from a qualified teacher and community skills expert.

















# **Fee Structure**

The fee for this program is \$250.00. A \$100.00 deposit is due with a completed registration form. The remaining \$150.00 is due on or **before January 16, 2026** (School Cash On-line is the preferred method of payment, or by credit card)

Included with the fee:

- 110 hours of boxing, wrestling, kick boxing, and jiu jitsu instruction
- 110 hours of instruction from a qualified teacher or community skills instructor
- Students will access the program through use of a school board issued city bus pass
- Minds In Motion Academic Program starter kit shorts, shirt, boxing gloves, MMA gloves, shin pads, and rash guard.

Financial assistance is available and will be reviewed on a case by case basis by request.

## **Transportation**

High school students will access city public transportation using their board issued city bus pass to the Steel City MMA facility located at 258 Queen St. E. Students are responsible for arriving at the Steel City MMA facility by 8:30 a.m. each day and return to their home schools at lunch using city bus transportation located next to the training facility.

#### **Equipment**

The Alliance Academy will supply students with a T-shirt, shorts, gloves, rash guard, and shin pads. All listed equipment will be provided in the starter kit with the activity fee.

#### **Admission Requirements/Considerations**

Enrolment in this program is limited thus, we cannot guarantee a spot for all applicants. Acceptance will be based on: work habits, consistent learning skills and regular attendance. Once program selection has been made by committee, a waiting list will be generated. Consideration will also be given to students who;

- Already participate in or are interested in martial arts or combat sports (wrestling, jiu jitsu, boxing, kickboxing etc.)
- Might be more successful in a non-traditional educational environment.
- Are interested in improving their overall health and well-being.
