# WHY ENROL IN GRADE 7 AND 8 AT WHITE PINES?

We believe all children *can* succeed and there are multiple pathways to excellence!

Our 7-12 Program provides students with a **gradual transition** into secondary school. Grade 7 and 8 students have described White Pines as a **mature environment** that provides intermediate students with specialized rooms, lockers, a cafeteria, athletics, extra-curricular clubs and the latest technology.

Depending on timetable availability, Grade 8 students (in consultation with parents) can **reach ahead** and take a Grade 9 class. They receive credit for the course giving them a head start in high school.

Grade 9 students often **reach back** to access their Grade 7 and 8 teachers for academic advice, counseling and support in their Grade 9 and 10 years. Strong relationships with caring adults improves student success.

## Outdoor Learning Program

White Pines is excited to offer an Outdoor Learning Program (OLP) as part of our intermediate program. Students in the program learn Ontario curriculum through a land-based learning model which strives to connect students to the earth, developing a sense of land-stewardship and environmental awareness. The OLP has strong connections to Indigenous culture, teachings and includes numerous **outdoor lessons, hands-on activities** and an **active exploration** of the world around us.



## Programming, Technology and Facility Highlights!

The Grade 7 and 8 curriculum expectations remain the same in our 7/8 Program. However, the curriculum can be taught differently because of the access to **specialized facilities** and **subject-specific teachers** who are able to teach in their areas of expertise.
