TOPIC ONE: CLASSROOM & SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLANNING

4 Hours

Host: School

Facilitator: School Administrators

Mode: In-Person Educators: All Staff

Educators will engage in improvement conversations where evidence of student learning over the month of September will be used to develop cycle 1 classroom improvement plans (September – November) based on the school's achievement priority. These classroom improvement plans outline the teacher practices and learning that will be implemented in response to students' needs and in support of every child's growth. This work is an integral part of ADSB's shared commitment to helping students thrive and make our schools even better places to learn and grow.

Note: Core French teachers will participate virtually for one hour in Teacher Triads, engaging in oral French language practice to support their classroom improvement work.
