# WHY ENROL IN GRADE 7 AND 8 AT KORAH COLLEGIATE?

**K**orah strives to provide the best possible educational environment, one which enables the individual to realize intellectual and personal potential within an atmosphere of cooperation and respect.

## The Korah 7 and 8 Program

Our 7-12 Program provides students with a **gradual transition** into secondary school. Students experience a **rotary timetable**, which makes the transition to a secondary school routine easier.

Grade 7 and 8 students find themselves in an environment that includes specialized rooms, lockers, a cafeteria, athletics, extra-curricular clubs and the most up to date technology.

Depending on timetable availability, Grade 8 students (in consultation with parents) can **reach ahead** and take a Grade 9 class. They receive credit for the course giving them a head start in high school.

Another bonus... Grade 9 students often **reach back** to access their Grade 7 and 8 teachers for academic advice, counseling and support in their Grade 9 and 10 years.

X-Block: Once a week the students are taught by a high school teacher to get an introduction to:

- Traditional Trades and Technology
- Personal Fitness and Nutrition
- Science and Technology
- The Arts

## Leadership Opportunities

Korah Collegiate is dedicated to developing leadership opportunities for all students through the Duke of Edinburgh Program, Athletics, Social Justice Initiatives, Environmental and Colts Cabinet Leadership Councils. 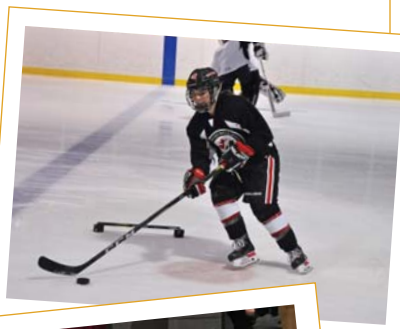


## Programming, Technology and Facility Highlights!
